Conditions for Transferring to the University of Hafr Al-Batin from Another University

- 1. Transferring a student to the preparation year is not permitted; the student must pass the courses in the preparatory year.
- 2. The student must have earned grades worth at least 24 credits and have completed at least two semesters of study at his university.
- 3. He cannot have stopped attending the university from which he wants to transfer, nor can he have been disciplined.
- 4. When filing a transfer application, the student's cumulative average and specialization average shall not be less than: (3.00 out of 5.00); (2.00 out of 4.00).
- 5. In accordance with the timeline established by the Deanship of Admission and Registration, the student submits a transfer request.
- 6. The potential student shouldn't have any prior academic history with the University of Hafr Al-Batin.
- 7. The College Council must approve the student's transfer.









Second: Under the following conditions, the College Council may waive the GPA criterion for female students requesting to transfer to the colleges mentioned in Paragraph 2 above:

- The existence of circumstances compelling the student to transfer to the University of Hafr Al-Batin, with supporting documentation submitted. (The death of the guardian, the retirement of the guardian, marriage, divorce, the transfer of the guardian outside the place of study, and the like).
- The student's grade article average (GPA) at the time of submitting the transfer request must be at least 2.50 out of 5.00 or 1.50 out of (4.00).
- The student shouldn't have previously attended Hafr Al-Batin University.
- The consent of the College Council to the student's transfer.
